

# The James Center for the Performing Arts

## Directions and Map

The James Center for the Performing Arts, comprised of an open-air stage and rehearsal room (Swisher Hall), is located in north Carrie Blake Park, within the Water Reuse Demonstration Site.

### **Directions traveling from east to west on Highway 101:**

From Highway 101 take the first Sequim exit onto Washington St. Travel 1.0 mile and turn right onto N. Blake Ave.

### **Directions traveling from west to east on Highway 101:**

Exit onto Sequim Ave., turn left (going north) and cross over Highway 101. At the traffic signal make a right turn onto E. Washington Street. Travel 0.8 mile on E. Washington St., (past the QFC shopping complex on the left) and move into the left-hand turn lane for N. Blake Ave.

### **Directions from the N. Blake Ave. and E. Washington St. intersection:**

Travel 0.5 mile north on N. Blake Ave, and then turn right at the intersection with E. Fir St. Travel counter clockwise through the Water Reuse Demonstration Site, making a right turn onto the one-way accessing The James Center and the Albert Haller Playfields.

The James Center is ahead on the right at the end of the parking lot. Band members park on the east and south sides of Swisher Hall, which is the tall building at the back of the stage. Also, the band parks south and southwest of Swisher Hall, including up to the extreme southern edge of the grass, which is under the trees & next Bell Creek.

Exit from the parking lot onto N. Rhodefer Rd. Travel to the 2<sup>nd</sup> stop sign to intersect with E. Washington St.
